## Writing a PhD grant application

In this workshop, we will work through the essential steps of a PhD grant application, from coming up with a fitting research question, to writing a detailed research plan and budget, ending with the work on ancillary documents such as your CV.

We will also take a closer look at the Doc.CH grant, with which the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) funds promising researchers in the humanities and social sciences to write a PhD dissertation on a topic of their own choice (application deadline: March 2024).

This workshop is aimed at advanced MA students who wish to apply for a PhD position in Switzerland or abroad.
